## Details about each class

**Research Reports** - Four incremental research reports with modified MLA citation method. Very step by step. Best for students who have been in one of Donna's earlier classes. Final papers will be sixteen to twenty-four paragraphs in length. Peer editing techniques taught; grammar incorporated into writing. Three to five hours homework per week. Class size limited to eight students. Grades 8-12 recommended levels. **Uses MC 9 I: Research Reports.** (See samples online.)

**Teacher: Donna Reish** Costs: \$ 10/ wk , plus \$32 book fee per student = \$152 total; Outside class time: 2-3 hrs / wk (essay required each wk)

**Beg Middle School Comp** - for middle school students who can already write one to three paragraph reports and essays. Various outlining techniques, Key Word Outline, Checklist Challenge. Creative and research writing. Class size limited to eight students. Grades 5-7 recommended (upper level students who have not done MC or CQLA in past and any 4-6th graders). **Uses MC 5 I.** (See samples at website.)

**Teacher: Donna Reish** Costs: \$ 10/ wk , plus \$32 book fee per student = \$152 total; Outside class time: 2-3 hrs / wk (essay required each wk)

**Beginning Creative Writing** - various types of creative writing: essays, timelines, what if, stories, Key Word Outlines with descriptive and literary techniques. Various outlining techniques and Checklist Challenge taught. Final papers will be give to twelve paragraphs in length. No MC or CQLA experience needed. **Uses MC 5 II: Creative and Clever.** (See samples at website.)

**Teacher: Cami Gross** Costs: \$ 8/ wk , plus \$32 book fee per student = \$128 total; Outside class time: 2-3 hrs / wk (essay required each wk)

**Intermediate Creative Writing** - 6th - 12th grade; various types of creative writing with more focus on goals, obstacles, and character development in story writing--plus dialogue and other techniques. Final papers will be six to fourteen paragraphs in length. MC 5 II graduates will enjoy this. **Uses MC 7 II: Completely Creative.** (See samples at website.)

**Teacher: Donna Reish** Costs: \$ 10/ wk , plus \$32 book fee per student = \$152 total; Outside class time: 2-3 hrs / wk (essay required each wk)

**Literary Analysis II (British / American)** - In depth studies of three literary works. **Not dependent upon Lit I.** Again, students will learn thinking, comprehension, reading, and writing skills!

**Teacher: Joshua Reish** Costs: \$ 10/ wk , plus \$12 copies fee per student = \$132 total + secure own books; Outside class time: 2 hrs /wk (essay required each wk)

**Beg or Adv Sign Language** - for elementary through high school students; call if interested as this class would probably be held at a different location

**Teacher: Cami Gross** Costs: \$ 10/ wk , plus buy own book; Outside class time: 2-3 hrs / wk (essay required each wk)

**Elementary / Middle School Speech** - for elementary through middle school students who want to start a soft introduction to public speaking. Informative, dramatic, book reports are just a few types of speeches that will be taught. By the end of class, your student will have the confidence to stand up and speak.

**Teacher: Cami Gross** Costs: \$ 8/ wk , plus \$8 book fee per student = \$104 total; Outside class time: 2-3 hrs / wk speech required each week

**Research Paper** - for high school students; students will learn MLA format of preparing a research paper. This is great preparation for college and this type of paper is required in many (most) college classes. Learn to research, organize, and site sources. Class size limit to 6 due to editing. **Uses MC 12: The Research Report**

**Teacher: Donna Reish** Costs: \$ 10/ wk , plus \$32 book fee per student = \$152 total; Outside class time: 2-3 hrs / wk (essay required each wk)

**Physics** - for high school students; Using Apologia's Physics book, learn the concepts of physics - how everything in the universe works with and affects everything else. Many class experiments to solidify your understanding. Algebra and trigonometry required as prerequisites.

**Teacher: Ray Reish** Costs: \$ 10/ wk , \$2/month lab plus buy your own book; Outside class time: 2-3 hrs / wk

**Biology** - for junior high through high school students; Using Apologia's Biology book, learn the concepts of Biology from Jonathan, who loves sciences and the opportunity to share his love for them.. Many class experiments including many dissections to solidify your understanding and learning.

**Teacher: Jonathan Reish** Costs: \$ 6/ wk , plus \$10 lab fee per month; buy your own book; Outside class time: 2-3 hrs / wk

**CQLA** - for elementary through high school students; separate sessions for each level. Complete Language Arts program including: vocabulary, spelling, editing, grammar, writing, and dictation. Class size limit to 6 due to editing.

**Influential People (World History)** -for junior high through high school students; An examination of twelve to sixteen people who influenced history for good or for bad--and what marks they left on history. Specifically studies key leaders who shaped their cultures and history; emphasizes western history while studying leaders from other parts of the world as well. Power Point; handouts; detailed lectures.

**Teacher: Joshua Reish** Costs: \$ 8/ wk , plus \$12 copies fee per student = \$108 total; Outside class time: 2-3 hrs / wk

**Story Writing** - for upper junior high through high school students; Students will learn various story writing techniques including goals, empathy, obstacles, character development, and more--all through biblical story examples. Students will write ten to fifteen page story at end. Prerequisite: lengthy written pieces.

**Teacher: Joshua Reish** Costs: \$ 10/ wk , plus \$32 book fee per student = \$152 total; Outside class time: 2-3 hrs / wk

**Speech and Debate (jr high - high school)** - for junior high through high school students; Joshua and Cami will use their strong speaking skills to give other the confidence to stand up in public and speak. Informative, persuasive, 3-point, dramatic, impromptu are just a few types of speeches that will be practiced. Basic public debating skills will be taught. These include how to write a debate case, how to listen, how to take notes, how to research, how to refute.

**Teacher: Joshua Reish or Cami Gross** Costs: \$ 6/ wk , \$1 copy / week , plus \$25 book fee per family = \$84 total + book; Outside class time: 2-3 hrs / wk (normally two speeches required each wk)
